Regathering Safety Protocols

- For everyone's safety, do not attend church in person if you are feeling sick. Please contact the office if you would like to be added to the prayer list.
- Please use a face covering over your nose and mouth (we have masks available if you need one).
- Kindly cleanse your hands with hand sanitizer upon entering the church.
- In order to facilitate cleaning the church, please take an "I sat here" flyer and leave it at your seat after Mass.
- An usher will ask for a first name and phone number for your household in case there is a COVID-19 case among the attendees.
- In order to decrease the risk of transmission, congregants who are not members of the same household must sit at least 6 feet apart.
- We regret that at this point it is still unsafe to resume congregational singing.
- We are unable to have physical exchanges of the Peace or the passing of the offering plate. (There will be one plate for leaving your offering, or you may donate electronically.)
- Communion will be by bread only, received in the hand. The priest will come to the entrance to the chancel, wearing a mask and having sanitized his hands. Communicants will come up the center aisle still wearing masks, observing the markers to stay six feet apart. Upon receiving communion, move at least six feet to the side (also marked) before removing your mask and consuming the host. Hand sanitizer will be available for cleaning your hands after receiving communion. Return to your pew by the side aisles. Equivalent procedures will apply to the daily masses in the Lady Chapel.
